Showers bring relief, power cuts too for Hyderabad

AMID the gloom of Covid-19, the pre-monsoon showers and resultant pleasant weather provided a much-needed break for people in Hyderabad and other parts of the State. The south-west monsoon is expected to arrive in Telangana in the next 48 hours, said India Meteorology Department-Hyderabad meteorologist, B Raja Rao.

The IMD has issued a warning that heavy to very heavy rainfall is likely occur at isolated places across Telangana

District update
Bhongir recorded a whopping 151.3 mm rainfall within 12 hours from Wednesday morning, highest in the State. This was followed by 126.5 mm at Bommalaramam in the same district and 118mm at Boath in Adilabad district

Wednesday, almost all districts recorded rainfall. A significant amount of rainfall was recorded in the suburbs of Greater Hyderabad also, with Abdullapurmet recording 74.8 mm followed by 63.8 mm in Pedda Amberpet.

With the continuous rains, came the power cuts. In many parts of the city, it lasted for more than three hours as uprooted trees damaged power lines. The Disaster Response Force of GHMC had a busy day tending to complaints of uprooted trees and roads with stagnant rainwater causing traffic jams.

Serum survey: Few found to be positive

According to an official press release, in the serum survey it was found that in Telangana, very few people were found to be positive from among the samples collected.

The ICMR and NIN had conducted serum surveys in rural areas of Jangaon, Kamareddy and Nalgonda from May 15 to 17 at the rate of 400 samples from each district. Of them, only four were found to be positive. In the survey done in five containment zones of Adibatla, Tappachabutra, Miyapur, Chandanagar and Balapur on May 30 and 31, as many as 100 samples were collected from each zone.

Of them only 15 had tested positive. Health Minister Eatla Rajender, said the results showed that the Telangana government had effectively implemented lockdown and the dedicated services rendered by medical staff had helped.

Bribery case: Revenue officials take advantage of high land value

DAYS after the Anti Corruption Bureau (ACB) officials arrested Shaikpet Tahsildar, Revenue Inspector, and Banjara Hills Sub-Inspector for their involvement in extraction of bribe from a land owner for closing a police case registered against him, the sleuths are all set to seek police custody of the accused officers for further questioning them.

The ACB officials have filed a petition in the court seeking custody of the accused officers for questioning. It is reported that the officials have obtained leads in connection with Tahsildar Sujatha acquiring illegal properties by misusing her powers. The ACB officials inquired about petitions filed before the Tahsildar in last couple of months and learnt the reasons for keeping them pending. The officers are trying to find out if any senior revenue official is also involved in the scandal.

The ACB officials also enquired private persons on whether they helped Sujatha in getting mamools (bribe). The upscale localities such as Banjara Hills, Jubilee Hills and other places come under Shaikpet Tahsildar's office and the revenue staff took advantage of land disputes to rake in a moolah.

Personal business

A day after the ACB arrested the Pedda Amberpet Municipal Commissioner L Venkata Ravinder Rao for collecting a bribe, they found that the accused officer was into business by investing his ill-gotten money.

Lockdown: Metro incurs heavy loss

Hyderabad Metro incurs ₹90 cr loss in 2 months; L&T paying ₹1,300 cr in interest every year

WHETHER it was the TSRTC, local trains or cab aggregators, there was no public transport available in the city during the two-month lockdown period.

However, one of the most affected during the Covid crisis was the Hyderabad Metro Rail, which incurred a loss of revenue amounting to ₹90 crore within a span of two months. With no communication from

the Central government about the reopening of its services, Hyderabad's icon of urbanisation is set to lose close to ₹45 crore every month as long as it remains idle.

According to L&T Metro Rail's latest financial audit report published in May, during the last financial year the company generated a revenue of ₹590 crore solely from the operation of the metro. On an average, the project generated an income of

₹45 crore each month. Visuals from metro stations in the city reveal that mechanisms of social distancing, spacing between seats, and, line stickers have already been put in place. The metro is also incurring expenditure that includes the maintenance cost of trial runs during the lockdown.

Managing Director of Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited, NVS Reddy, told *Express*, "We

have sent recommendations from our side to the Central government. However, we cannot proceed unless the Centre gives us a green signal." Earlier this year, Reddy had revealed that L&T was paying close to ₹1,300 crore in interest every year. The cost of the project has increased up to ₹21,000 crore. A reliable source told *Express*, "It will take a ridership of over 9 lakh passengers every day, for an entire year, for the project to break even."

TS issues GO to promote all Class X students

THE Telangana government on Wednesday issued a Government Order (GO) to promote all Class X students to the next class for the academic year 2019-2020 considering their internal assessment marks.

Soon after the government announced the promotion of SSC students, the schools uploaded internal assessment marks obtained by the students in the four assessment tests, on the Directorate of Government Examinations (DGE) website.

"The internal assessment marks data pertaining to all the candidates appearing for SSC examinations is readily available with DGE for the purpose of declaring Grade points," the order read.

The government permitted DGE, to declare all students of Class X appearing for Secondary School Certificate (SSC) exam, OSSC, and vocational courses, studying in all government, aided, and private-unaided schools under various managements as pass, duly considering their performance in internal assessments for 20 per cent marks to 100 per cent.
