The architect/consultant at the directions of the SBI from time time issue furtherdrawingsand/orwriteinstructions, details directions and explanations which are hereafter collectivelyreferencestoasArchitect's/consultant'sinstructionsinregardtothevariationormodification of the design, quality or quantity of any work the addition omission substitution work. or or or discrepancyinthedrawingsorbetweenBOQand/ordrawingsand/orspecifications. Theremoval from the site of any material brought thereon by the Contractor and any substitution of any other materials therefore the removal and/or re-execution of any work executed by him. The dismissal from the work of any person engaged the re upon.

5.0 i)LetterofAcceptance:

Within the validity period of the tender the SBI shall issue a letter of acceptance directly or through the architectbyregisteredpostorotherwisedepositingattheofthecontractorasgiveninthetendertoenter intoaContractfortheexecutionoftheworkasperthetermsofthetender. ii)ContractAgreement:

6.0 Ownership of drawings:

Alldrawings, specifications and copies the reoffurnished by the SBI through its Architect/consultants are the properties of the SBI. They are not to be used on other work.

Detaileddrawingsandinstructions:

The SBIthrough its architects/consultants shall furnish with reasonable proper additional instructions by means of drawings or otherwise necessary for the execution of the work. All such drawings and instructions shall be consistent with contract documents, true developments thereof and reasonably inferable there.

Copiesofagreement:

8.0 Liquidateddamages:

If the contractor fails to maintain the required progress in terms of clause 6.0 of GOC or to complete the work and clear the site including vacating their office on or before the contracted or extended date or completion, without justification insupport of the cause of delay, hemay becalled upon without prejudice to any other right of remedy available under the law to the SBI on account of such breach to pay aliquidated damages at the rate of 0.50% of the contract value which subject to a maximum of 5% of the contract value.

9.0 Materials, Appliances and Employees:

Unlessorotherwisespecifiedthecontractorshallprovideandpayforallmaterials, labour, water, power, tools, equipment transportation and any other facilities that are required for the satisfactory execution and completion of the work. Unless or otherwise specified all materials shall be new and both workmanship and materials shall be best quality. The contractor shall at all times enforce strict discipline and good order among his employees and shall not employ on the work any unfit person or anyone not skilled in the work assigned to him. Workman whose work or behavior is found to be unsatisfactory by the SBI /Architect/ consultant he shall be removed from the site immediately.

10.0 Permits, Laws and Regulations:

expenses. The contractor shall give notices and comply with the regulations, laws, and ordinances rules, applicable to the contract. If the contractor observes any discrepancy between the drawings and specifications, he shall promptly notify the SBI in writing under intimation of the Architect/ Consultant. If the contractor performs any act, which is against the law, rules and regulations he shall meet all the costs arising the reform and shall indemnify the SBI any legal actions arising there from.

11.0 SettingoutWork:

The contractor shall take insurance covers as per clause at his own cost. The policy may be taken in joint names of the contractor and the SBI and the original policy may be lodged with the SBI

13.0 Inspectionofwork:

delaythatmightoccurinapprovingthesamplesforreasonsofitsnotmeetingthespecificationsorother discrepancies inadequacy in AIRCONDITIONING MATERIAL samples of best qualities from various manufacturers and such other aspects causing delay on the approval of the materials / equipment etc. shall betotheaccountofthecontractor.

16.0 Obtaining information related to execution of work:

No claim by the contractor for additional payment shall be entertained which is consequent upon failure on his part to obtain correct information as to any matter affecting the execution of the work nor any misunderstandingortheobtainingincorrectinformationorthefailuretoobtaincorrectinformationrelieve him from any risks or from the entire responsibility for the fulfillment of contract.

<u>17.0 Contractor's superintendence:</u>

The contractor shall give necessary personal superintendence during the execution the works and as long, thereafter, as the Architect/Consultant may consider necessary until the expiry of the defects liability period, stated hereto.

The contractor howevershall not be required to provide any plant ormaterial for the execution of such work except by special arrangement with the SBI. - b) TherightofSBltoexecutetheworksoranypartthereofon, over, under, in orthrough any lands.
- c) Injuriesordamagestopersonsorpropertieswhichareunavoidableresultoftheexecutionor maintenance of the works in accordance with the contract.
- d) Injuries or damage to persons or property resulting from any act or neglect of the SBI their agents, employees or other contractors not being employed by the contractor or for or in respect of any claims, proceedings,damages,costs,chargesandexpensesinrespectthereoforinrelationtheretoorwheretheinjuryor damage was contributed to by the contractor, his servants or agents such part of thecompensation as may be just and equitable having regard to the extent of the responsibility of the SBI, theiremployees, or agents or other employees, or agents or other contractors for the damage or injury.

27.0 ContractortoindemnifySBI:

The contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified SBI against all such damages and compensation, save and except as a foresaid, and against all claims, proceedings, costs, charges and expenses what so ever in respect the reof or in relation thereto.

32.0 Insuranceagainstaccidentsetc.toworkmen:

The contractors hall insure against such liability with an insurer approved by the SBID uring the whole of the time that any persons are employed works and shall, when required. produce to the architect/consultantsuch the policyofinsuranceandreceiptforpaymentofthecurrentpremium. Subjecttoanyprovisiontothecontrarycontainedinthecontractnopermanentworkshallsaveasherein provided be carried on during the night oron holidays without the permission in writing of the Architect/consultant, save whenthe workis unavoidableorabsolutely necessaryfor the saving of lifeor property or for the safety of the work in which case the contractors hall immediately advise the Architect/consultant. However the provisions of the clause shall not be applicable in the case of any work which becomes essential to carry by rotary or doubleshifts in order to achieve the progress and quality of the part of the works being technically required / continued with the prior approval of the Architect / consultant at no extra cost to the SBI

#### **SPECIFICATIONSOFMATERIALSTOBEUSED**

#### General:

Thesespecifications are for the worktobeexecuted items to be supplied and materials to be used in the works as shown and defined on the drawings and described here in all under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the architect / employer.

Theworkmanshipistobethebestavailableandtoahighstandard. Usemustbemadeofspecialisttradesmen in all aspects of the works, and allowance must be made in therates for doing so.

Thematerials and items to be provided by the contractors hall be the best of their respective kinds, approved by the

architectinaccordancewithanysamples, which may be submitted for approval, and generally in accordance with the specification. Where materials or products are specified in this specification and/or bill of quantities by the name of the manufacture or the brand trade name or catalogue references the contractor will be required to obtain the approval of the architect/employer before using a material or product other than the specified. The contractor shall produce all invoices, vouchers or receipted accounts for any materials of called upon to do so by the architect.

Sample of all material are to be submitted to the architect for his approval before the contractor orders or deliversinbulktothesite. Also, the contractor will be required to submit specimen finishest occolors, fabrics etc. For

theapproval of the approval of the approval of the architect who will retain to copies, all at the contractors expenses.

#### **Materials**

The materials shall be of the best-approved quality obtainable and shall comply with the respective Indian standard specification. If directed, materials shall be estedinary approved testing laboratory and the test certificates in original shall

On completion, clean all glass inside and out, replace all cracked scratched or broken panes and leave in good condition to the satisfaction of the architect.


